

No Stirring Card



Project Skill Level: Beginner

Instructions

1. Fold 5½" x 8½" blue cardstock in half. This card will have a side fold.
2. Stamp the mouse image on the white cardstock using the Memento ink.
3. Color the image with Copic Markers. In this example, the holly leaves were colored with G05 and G17. R24, R29, and R39 were used on the holly berries. Use the R11 in the mouse's ears. The bowl and the outer circle were colored with the B34 marker. Color the spoon using YR21. Color the contents of the bowl with E99. The mouse was colored by blending the C1 and C3 markers. Use the W1 marker to put a shadow around the mouse and the holly. Also use it to color the dots on the apron.
4. Use the adhesive to attach the white cardstock with the colored image to the middle of the red cardstock.
5. Punch 2 holes about ¼" down from the top of the white cardstock. The holes should be in the middle of the white cardstock and about ¼" apart. Thread ribbon through the holes and tie a bow.
6. Use adhesive to attach the finished design to the middle of the blue card.

Mouse stamp from Sheet # XMFS01 - X-mas theme (SI)

Paper

5½" x 8½" blue cardstock, 4" x 5¼" red cardstock, 5" x 3¾" white cardstock compatible with Copic markers

Inks

Tuxedo Black Memento (SI), Copic Markers in the following colors - O(Blender), E99, B000, B34, R11, R24, R29, R39, G05, G17, YR21, YG03, W1, C1, C3

Accessories

coordinating ribbon, adhesive of your choice, ¼" hole punch
