

## Cute Bunny Card



Project Skill Level: Beginner

## Supplies

### Stamps

Easter #1 - SUEZSET01 (SI))

### Paper

3¼" x 3¼" Georgia Pacific White, 8½" x 4¼" light peach card stock, 2" x 4¼" medium peach card stock

### Inks

Tuxedo Black Memento (SI), Copic Markers in the following colors – B0000, B24, BG32, BV00, BV13, C1, C3, R43, R81, RV17, YG03, YG63, YR61

### Accessories

adhesive of your choice, scissors, post-it notes or other material for masking

## Instructions

1. All stamping will be done with the memento ink. Stamp the Easter bunny with egg onto the white card stock. Mask the bunny image.

NOTE: To mask an image, stamp the foreground image onto a Post-It note or other material for masking. After it dries, you will need to cut out the image. Be sure to cut as close to possible to the inked line. Place this cut-out over the image on the white card stock. Then you will continue with stamping other images.

2. Add an image of the outlined egg to the left of the bunny. Add one more outlined egg image, this time to the right of the bunny.
3. Remove the mask.
4. Add a butterfly stamp near the top left of the bunny image.
5. Add the "Happy Easter" image to the right of the bunny.
6. Color the images on the white card stock with Copic Markers. In this example, the bunny was colored with the C1 and C3 markers. Its ears and feet were colored in with R81. The eyes were colored with B24.
7. The egg on the left side of the bunny was colored with BG32. The egg on the right side of the bunny was colored with YR61. The egg the bunny is holding was colored with the R43 marker.
8. The butterfly image was colored with BV00, BV13, RV17, YG03 and YG23.
9. Fill in the background with B0000, and C1 under the bunny.
10. Highlight "Happy Easter" with BV000. Set this colored image aside.
11. Fold the light peach card stock in half. The fold for this card will be on the top.
12. Use adhesive of your choice to attach the medium peach cardstock to the left side of the light peach cardstock.
13. Use the adhesive to apply the white card stock, with the colored image, onto the middle of the card.
