

Sleepy Bunny Card



Project Skill Level: Beginner

Supplies

Stamps

Easter #1 - SUEZSET01 (SI)

Paper

3" x 4¼" Georgia Pacific White card stock, 3½" x 4¾" bright yellow card stock, 5½" x 8½" robin's egg blue card stock

Inks

Tuxedo Black Memento (SI), Copic Markers in the following colors – B000, B02, C1, C3, E19, G02, R81, Y06, YR02, W1; black Sakura Pigma Micron 03 archival ink pen (or other archival quality ink pen)

Accessories

adhesive of your choice, scissors, post-it notes or other material for masking

Instructions

1. All stamping will be done with the memento ink. Stamp the paint cans image on the white card stock. Mask the paint cans.

NOTE: To mask an image, stamp the foreground image onto a Post-It note or other material for masking. After it dries, you will need to cut out the image. Be sure to cut as close to possible to the inked line. Place this cut-out over the image on the white card stock. Then you will continue with stamping other images.

2. Add the bunny on the egg image behind the left side of the basket.
3. Remove the mask.
4. Add some lines with the archival ink pen to form stripes on the egg.
5. Color the images on the white card stock with Copic Markers. In this example, the bunny was colored with the C1 and C3 markers. Its ears were colored in with R81.
6. The paint brush handle was colored with E19. The paint on the brush, the puddle of paint at the bottom of the egg, and the paint in the larger can were colored with YR02.
7. The top of the egg, and the paint in the smaller can were colored using the B04 marker.
8. The next stripe on the egg was colored with Y06.
9. The third stripe on the egg was colored with the G02 marker. The bottom of the egg was left white.
10. The paint cans were colored with the C1 and C3 markers.
11. Use the W1 marker to add shadow to the image. Be sure to add some shadow below the image.
12. Use the B000 marker to color in the background behind the bunny on the egg.
13. Fold the blue card stock in half. The fold for this card will be on the side.
14. Use adhesive of your choice to attach the yellow card stock to the middle of the blue card stock.
15. Use the adhesive to apply the white card stock, with the colored image, onto the middle of the yellow card stock.
