

Easter Basket Card



Project Skill Level: Beginner

Supplies

Stamps

Easter #1 - SUEZSET01 (SI)

Paper

4" x 7" Georgia Pacific White card stock, 4½" x 7½" violet card stock, 8½" x 11" pale apricot card stock

Inks

Tuxedo Black Memento (SI), Copic Markers in the following colors – B000, B29, BG10, BG32, E11, E13, E51, E99, R81, V0000, V12, V15, W1, Y02, Y11, Y17, YG63, YR21, YR61

Accessories

adhesive of your choice, scissors, post-it notes or other material for masking



Instructions

1. All stamping will be done with the Memento ink. Stamp the Easter basket image on the white card stock. Mask the basket.

NOTE: To mask an image, stamp the foreground image onto a Post-It note or other material for masking. After it dries, you will need to cut out the image. Be sure to cut as close to possible to the inked line. Place this cut-out over the image on the white card stock. Then you will continue with stamping other images.

2. Add the flag image behind the left side of the basket.
3. Add an image of the outlined egg to the left of the basket. Add one outlined egg image to the right of the basket. Mask this egg image. Add one more egg on the right side of the basket.
4. Add a butterfly to the right of the flag.
5. Remove the masks.
6. Color the images on the white card stock with Copic Markers. In this example, the Easter basket was colored with the E11, E13, and YR21 markers. The post was colored with E13, and E99. The E51 and Y11 markers were used on the flag. The butterfly was completed using V12, V15, and YG63.
7. The egg on the left side of the basket was colored with YR61. The two eggs on the right side of the basket were colored with R81 and BG10. The eggs in the basket were colored with B000 and B29 (egg with polka dots); Y17 and Y62 (striped egg); BG 10 and BG32 (egg with stars in circles); V0000, V12, and V15 (flowered egg); R81 and YG63 (egg with vine); and YR61 (egg with stars).
8. Add the stamp "Egg-stra Special" on the flag using the black ink.
9. Use the W1 marker to add shadow to the image. Be sure to add some shadow below the image. Set aside.
10. Fold the pale peach card stock in half. The fold for this card will be on the side.
11. Use adhesive of your choice to attach the violet card stock to the middle of the pale apricot card.
12. Use the adhesive to apply the white card stock, with the colored image, onto the middle of the violet card stock.
