

## Floral Image Card



Project Skill Level: Beginner

## Supplies

### Stamps

Love Flowers stamp set MSET09 (SI)

### Paper

2 different papers from the Basic Grey Phresh and Phunky collection (1 should measure 3" x 4½"; the other should measure 3¾" x 5"), 5 ½" x 8 ½" pink card stock, a scrap of white card stock to fit the oval shape

### Inks

Memento Tuxedo Black ink pad (SI)

### Accessories

adhesive of your choice, pink gemstones, Martha Stewart Edger - Doily, 3" oval punch, Decorating Chalks, make-up applicators and/or cotton swabs

## Instructions

1. Punch an oval shape from the white card stock.
2. Use the black ink to stamp floral image onto the oval shape.
3. Color the image with the chalks using the make-up applicators as coloring tools. In this example the roses were colored with the pink chalk. The other flowers with the salmon chalk. The leaves were colored using the sage green chalk. The back ground was colored with the light purple chalk. Set the oval shape aside.
4. Fold the pink card stock in half. This card will have a side fold.
5. Use the Doily Punch on the 3¾" side of the Basic Grey paper. Adhere this paper to the front of the pink card stock. It should be placed ½" down from the top of the card.
6. Place the 3" x 4½" paper on top of the paper from step 5. This paper should be placed ¼" down from the top of the card. Attach with adhesive of your choice.
7. Attach the oval to the middle of the paper from step 6.
8. Place one of the larger gemstones about ½" down from the top of the card at 2¼" from the left.
9. Place a small gemstone ½" to the left of the center gemstone. Add another gemstone ½" to the left of the last one.
10. Place a small gemstone ½" to the right of the center gemstone. Add another gemstone ½" to the right of the last one.
