

Border Background ATCs

Supplies

Stamps: Dee Gruenig's Watercolor Flower 1 ATC Set (SI), Gruenig's Borders 1 ATC Set (SI),

Paper: ATC-sized pieces (2½" x 3½") of 2@ lettuce green, 1@ butterscotch, and 2@ caramel card stock; 3@ Xerox 65# Flecs Cover

Ink: Kaleidacolor stamp pad in Creole Spice

Accessories: lime green Stickles, adhesive of your choice, small scissors, foam mounting adhesive; 2" oval punch

Directions

1. Ink a border stamp on the Kaleidacolor pad. Stamp onto the left and right edges of the Flecs cover. Ink the border stamp again. This time, stamp the image 1" down from the top and beside each of the previously stamped images. Re-ink again and stamp in the middle of the card 2" down from the top edge of the card.
2. Keeping the stamp in the same direction, ink and stamp onto the ATC. You will be filling in the 1" spaces and the 2" space with the image
3. Stamp 2 flower stamps (using the blue color on the ink pad) onto the third piece of Flecs stock. Cut out the flowers leaving a slight margin around the image.
4. Put a small amount of the Stickles in the middle of each flower image. Set aside to dry.
5. Punch 2 ovals from the butterscotch card stock and set aside.
6. Trim the caramel colored card stock by ½" on one short side and one long side. Adhere the card stock to the green card stock.
7. Cut off ¼" piece from the stamped Flecs cover on one short side and one long side. Adhere this piece on top of the caramel colored card stock.
8. Attach the oval to the middle of the ATC with foam mounting adhesive.
9. Stick the one flower onto each oval with mounting foam.
