

## Borders Bookmark

### Supplies

Stamps: Dee Gruenig's Borders 1 ATC Set (SI)  
Paper: Bazzill black cardstock (2 pieces @ 2" x 6")  
Ink: assortment of Tombow Markers (your choice of colors), VersaColor #80 white ink  
Accessories: Ranger Seafoam White embossing powder, embossing heat tool, several colors of 12" ribbon, ¼" hole punch, adhesive of your choice

### Directions

1. Line up several border stamps on acrylic block.
2. Ink stamps with VersaColor and stamp images on 1 piece of black card stock. Reapply ink and stamp again to complete covering the bookmark with images.
3. Sprinkle images with white embossing powder. Shake off excess. Use embossing heat tool to melt powder.
4. Apply adhesive to back of bookmark. Attach the other piece of card stock to make bookmark more stable.
5. Use the Tombow markers to color on top of the embossed images. You may want to color over the images several times. This will depend on the depth of color you'd like to achieve.
6. When you're satisfied with the color, punch a hole in the top portion of the bookmark.
7. Attach the ribbons to the bookmark.
