

Flowers and Pearls ATCs

Supplies

Stamps: Dee Gruenig's Watercolor Flower 1 ATC Set (SI)

Paper: 110# white index cardstock, Bazzill Flamingo cardstock, 65# white cardstock or text weight paper

Ink: Dee Gruenig's Shades of Sunrise Blending Blox(SI), Tombow marker #N15

Accessories: Hero Arts pink self-adhesive pearls, Xyron create-a-sticker or adhesive of your choice, Fiskars Sunburst Border punch, scissors



Directions

1. Cut the flamingo cardstock into 4 2½" x 3½" pieces for the Artist Trading Cards.
2. Cut the white 110# cardstock into 4 – 1¼" x 3¼" pieces.
3. Choose 4 floral stamps from the set. Ink a stamp with the Shades of Sunrise Blending Blox and stamp onto one of the 4 white 110# pieces. You will stamp a different image onto each of the 4 pieces of white cardstock.
4. Use the black Tombow marker to lightly edge the sides of each piece of white cardstock.
5. Using the Sunburst punch, make a piece of paper lace. Length should be 4". The width of lace in this project is about 7/8" wide.
6. Using the Xyron create-a-sticker, put all 4 pieces of paper lace through the Xyron (this adds adhesive to the back of the lace). Use the same method for the 4 floral image pieces.
7. Add a stamped image piece about 1/8" from the top, bottom, and right side of the flamingo ATC. Center the paper lace on the left side of the flamingo cardstock. Trim off the extra lace at the top and bottom of the ATC card. Add the images and lace to the other 3 ATCs.
8. Add the pink self-adhesive pearls into the middle of the paper lace.
7. Use the same 2 floral stamps as used in step 5. (One for each vase.) Stamp flowers, into the main vase images, with the dusty concord ink.
