Christmas Pop-Up Card

Supplies

Stamps: Best of Dee Gruenig *Ho, Ho, Ho ATC Set* (SI)

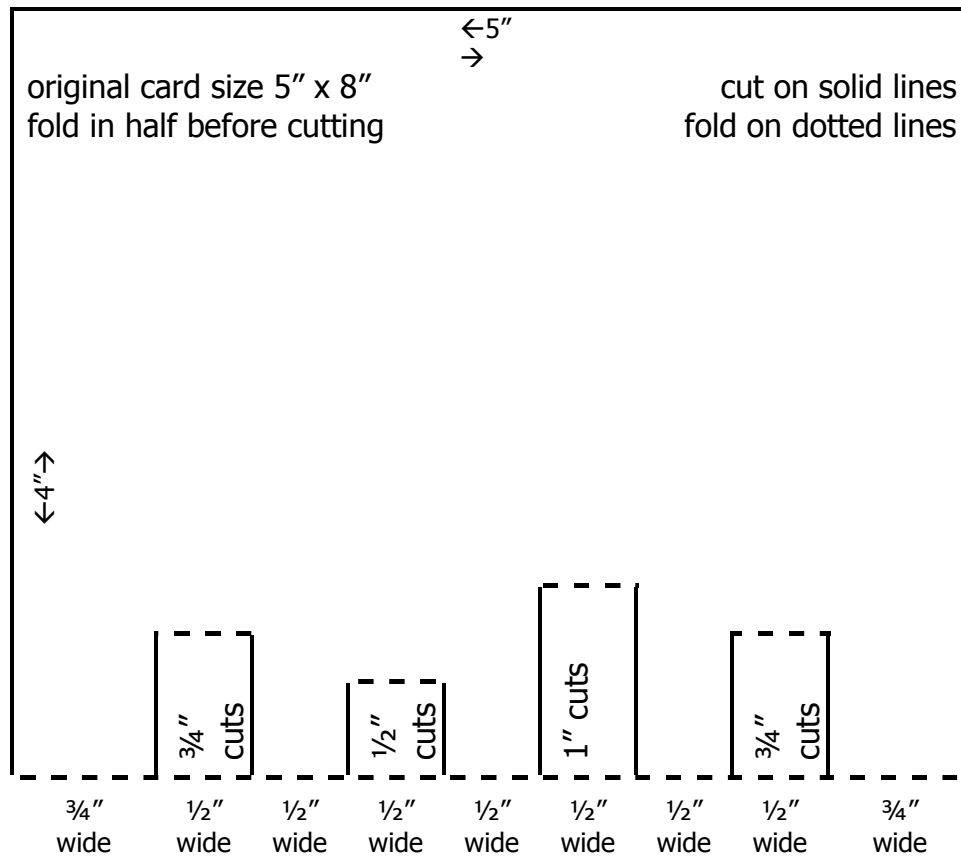
Paper: 8½" x 11" white card stock, 8½" x 5½" green card stock, 4" x 5" decorative paper

Accessories: Marvy Brush Markers #1 Black and #113 Bright Red, #109 Chocolate and #110 Caramel (SI), Tombow marker #970, Copic Marker #E51 Milky White, Sakura 005 Micron pens in red and brown, 03 Micron pen in black, blue Glaze pen, and pink Soufflé pen; assorted colors Spica glitter pens, Tulip Puffy white fabric paint, small scissors, Marvy heat embossing tool (SI), adhesive of your choice

Directions

1. Cut card stock into 2 5½" x 8½" pieces. Set one aside for the pop-up part of the card.
2. Using red and black Brush Markers, color on Santa stamp. Color the mittens and boots with black. Color the suit and hat with red. Huff onto the inked stamp and stamp once on card stock. Color the belt buckle and buttons with the glitter pen. Add additional red or black marker to the stamped image if desired.
3. Apply Puffy Paint in the areas for the cuffs, end of hat, and bottom of coat. Allow to slightly dry. Carefully apply heat from the embossing heat tool to the paint. The paint will puff up. Cut this Santa from the card stock.
4. Clean off the Santa stamp. Apply the Tombow marker to the head portion of the Santa. Stamp once on the card stock with Santa image. Use the brown Micron pen to color the eyebrows. Use the pink Soufflé pen on the nose. Use the blue Glaze pen on the eyes. Color the facial area with the Milky White Copic marker. Put puffy paint in the mustache area. Allow to dry for a bit, and then apply heat. Now apply the puffy paint to the beard area. Allow this application to slightly dry, and then apply heat from the embossing heat tool.
5. Cut out the face and beard area, apply adhesive and attach to the Santa body. Put puffy paint in the trim area of the hat. Let this slightly dry. Use the heat embossing tool to puff the paint.
6. Use the 2 brown Marvy markers and the black Marvy marker to color in the reindeer stamp. Huff onto the inked stamp and stamp onto cardstock. Color the hooves with #10 black glitter pen. Use #03 Red Spica glitter pen to color in the nose. Cut out the image.
7. Use the #129 Posh Green, #131 Sunny Yellow and #109 Chocolate Marvy markers to color a tree stamp. Huff onto the inked stamp and stamp image onto cardstock. Color the star with # #05 Lemon glitter pen. Cut out the image.

8. Use the #121 Very Violet Marvy marker to color the Ho Ho Ho stamp. Huff onto the inked stamp and stamp image onto cardstock. Color in the ornaments with glitter pens of your choice. Cut out the image.
9. Cut $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the white $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " cardstock. Fold this 5" x 8" cardstock in half. This card will have a top fold. Apply adhesive to the back of the 4" x 5" decorative paper. Place the decorative paper on one end of the card. This will end up being the backdrop for the pop-up images.
10. Refer to the following diagram for cutting instructions. Use a stylus to score the ends of the cut sections. This will allow easier folding.



11. Fold the cut sections toward the inside of the card. These sections will be where you will attach the images prepared in earlier steps.
12. Using adhesive, attach the 4 images to the 4 sections that were folded toward the inside of the card. Make sure that you glue the images to the bottom of the pop-up section that doesn't have decorative paper on it.
13. Fold the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " cardstock in half. Use adhesive to attach the white card with pop-ups to the inside of the green card.
14. Add a greeting to the front of the green card as desired.
