

Good Luck Card

Supplies

Stamps: Dee Gruenig's ATC Mini Words good luck! (SI), small daisy stamp (SI), zig zag brush background (SI)

Paper: 5½" x 8½" Bazzill Fawn card stock, 5" x 3¾" eggplant card stock, scraps of khaki and light tan card stocks

Ink: Ranger Adirondack stamp pad in Eggplant, bleach

Accessories: adhesive of your choice, 2½" scalloped circle punch, 2" circle punch, paper towels



Directions

1. Prepare for bleach stamping by placing several folded paper towels in a glass or plastic container. Saturate the towels with bleach. This will serve as your bleach stamping pad.
2. Tap zigzag stamp on the bleach stamping pad several times. Stamp diagonally onto the eggplant card stock. Set aside to dry.
3. Stamp daisy image onto khaki card stock using the bleach stamping pad. Set aside to dry.
4. Stamp the good luck stamp, onto a 2½" x 1" piece of tan card stock, with the eggplant ink.
5. Fold tan cardstock in half for card. This card will have the fold at the top.
6. Using adhesive, adhere eggplant card stock to center of front of card.
7. Use adhesive to attach the good luck image to the bottom left of the eggplant card stock. This should be about ½" in from the left and ½" up from the bottom.
8. Punch a scalloped circle from scrap of tan cardstock. Use the 2" circle punch to cut out the daisy image. Attach the daisy circle to the middle of the scalloped circle with your adhesive. Adhere these attached circles to the top right corner area of the eggplant card stock.
9. Be sure to clean your stamps in warm sudsy water when you are done with your project.
